[Independence Center Clubhouse Shop](#) is an upscale resale shop in the Central West End that provides support and employment to adults living with mental illnesses. They offer pickups.

[House Of Goods - Baitulmal](#) is the charity arm of the Islamic Foundation of Greater St. Louis. Located near Sublette Park, they distribute essentials to neighbors in need. They offer limited pickups.

[Oasis International](#) in the Bevo neighborhood helps resettle new refugees into our St. Louis community. They offer pickups of certain furniture donations, depending on current needs.

[LifeWise STL](#) is a social services hub located in the Soulard neighborhood, helping people overcome systemic barriers and economic challenges. Contact them directly to ask about large donations, as they have limited space to store furniture and housewares.

[Ditto Family Resale](#) is a high-end thrift store in Warson Woods that raises scholarship funds for students attending Christian private schools. They offer furniture pickups for a fee.

Habitat for Humanity is a long-standing organization that works to provide decent and affordable housing. They have ReStore locations with pickup services in [St. Louis](#), [St. Charles](#), and [Collinsville, IL](#). The [Jefferson County](#) location does not currently offer pickups.

[The Sharing Shed](#) is a furniture bank in O'Fallon, MO that provides furnishings to individuals and families transitioning out of crisis situations. They offer pickups only within St. Charles County.

[Refab STL](#) in South City focuses on the preservation, restoration, and creative re-use of salvaged building materials and furnishings. They offer limited pickups.

[Second Chances Resale Shop](#) is a thrift store benefitting Stray Rescue, helping animals find loving homes. They are located downtown and accept furniture drop-offs, but they do NOT offer pickups.

[St. Vincent de Paul](#) and [Salvation Army](#) are global organizations with multiple thrift store locations throughout STL city and county. Contact them to see if your zip code is eligible for free pickup.
