Our Executive Director

Dear Friends,

This past year marked a meaningful turning point for Home Sweet Home.

In 2025, we furnished homes for more than **1,200 families**—the most families served in a single year in our history. That milestone brought our total impact to **7,443 families** served to date, each one moving into a home with greater stability and dignity.

As we marked our **10-year anniversary**, we also focused on strengthening the organization behind the mission—ensuring Home Sweet Home is built not just to meet today’s needs, but to serve our community well for years to come.

When families across our region were displaced by the **May 2025 tornado**, we were able to respond quickly—without slowing our core services—because of the systems, partnerships, and capacity already in place. It was a powerful reminder that strong infrastructure allows compassion to move faster.

Throughout the year, we focused on several key areas of organizational leadership and growth:

- **Planning for the future** through a new strategic plan and feasibility study to guide our next phase of growth.
- **Strengthening internal operations** with a comprehensive employee handbook and a transition to a PEO payroll service to better support our staff.
- **Expanding our leadership** beyond St. Louis through the launch of *Furnish Together*, a national coalition of furniture banks working collaboratively to address furniture poverty at scale.

These milestones were made possible by donors who believe in doing this work well and who understand that lasting impact requires both heart and strategy.

Thank you for your trust, your partnership, and your belief in what’s possible when we build this work together.

Tornado Relief

The **May 16 tornado** left many of our neighbors facing unimaginable loss. Home Sweet Home quickly mobilized to support both immediate relief and long-term recovery across our community.

In response, Home Sweet Home:

- Turned our warehouse into a **tornado relief hub** for two months following the storm, using our space, trucks, and team to collect and transport essential items to distribution sites.
- Added **North Side Community School** as a new partner agency to connect directly with families affected.
- Furnished homes for **more than 150 tornado survivors** once families were able to secure new housing.

A CLIENT STORY

Corli's Journey with Home Sweet Home

For Corli, the path to stability has never been simple.

The passing of her mother, time in the shelter system, and a serious fall that left her injured made the journey far from easy. Still, she remained determined to finish her education and build a stable future. When she was finally able to continue her studies, she faced yet another challenge: she had just moved and had no furniture.

Then she learned about Home Sweet Home.

“I was so happy. I was ecstatic when I got the call to set up the appointment.”

When Corli arrived, the space itself made an immediate impression. The welcoming reception area, the carefully organized furniture, and the thoughtful layout made it clear that this was more than a warehouse of donated items. It was a place designed to help people create a home.

“The reception was beautiful and felt like it was full of love... The selection was incredible... Like, a literal dream come true, but somehow much, much better.”

What stayed with Corli most, though, was the way she was treated throughout the experience. From the moment she walked in, the staff made her feel seen, supported, and deserving of this opportunity to rebuild.

“You can tell the people wanted to be there and to make you feel like, ‘this is your break, you deserve this.’”

As she selected furniture and home essentials, Corli began to picture something she had rarely experienced before—a space that truly felt like her own. With each piece she chose, the vision of her home came together.

“I teared up as I saw my home come to life for the very first time in my adult years. That joy. That warmth. The deep gratitude that formed in my heart.”

Today, Corli enjoys the everyday comforts that many people take for granted. She has welcomed family and friends into her home and feels proud to share the space she created. Sleeping in a bed instead of on the floor has improved her health and helped ease the pain from her injury, and the small moments—a cup of coffee, a shared meal, a comfortable place to rest—feel meaningful in ways they once didn't.

“I get to look at and experience my home with the things that I personally picked daily, and it never gets old. Thank you for equipping me with a better future and beautiful present.”

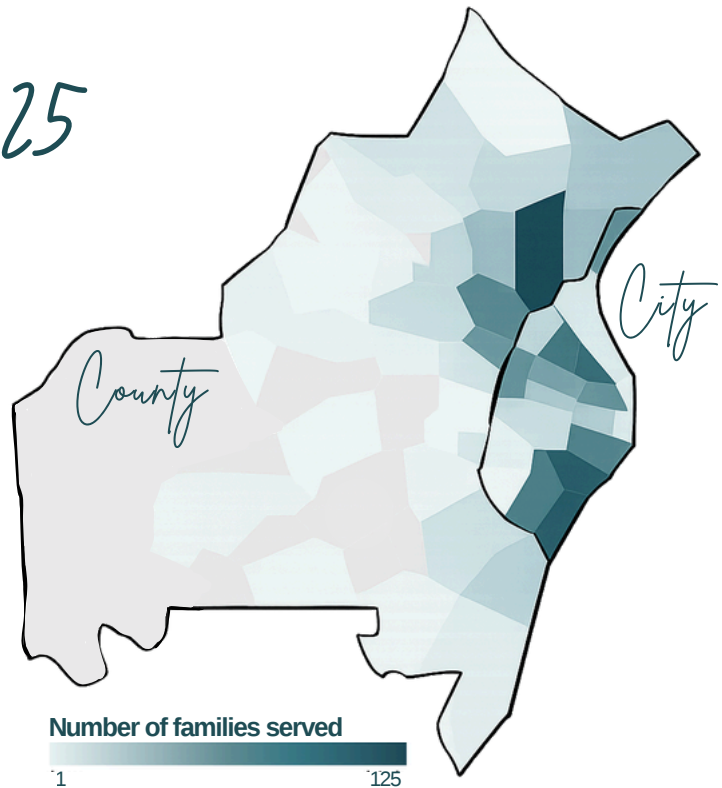

Others host **donation drives**, collecting essential household items that help us keep our warehouse stocked for the families we serve. This past year, community drives brought in more than **3,250 household items**.



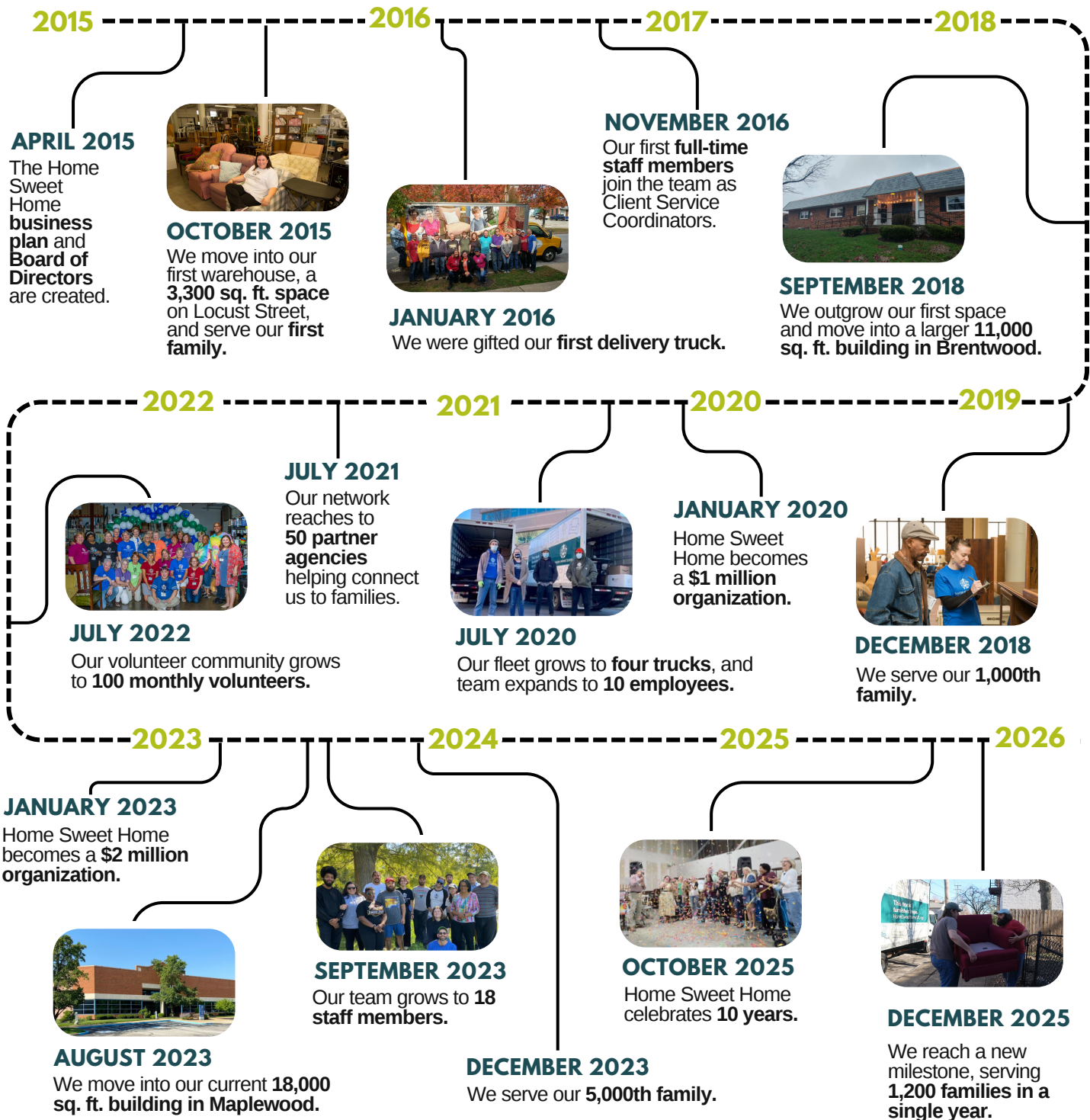

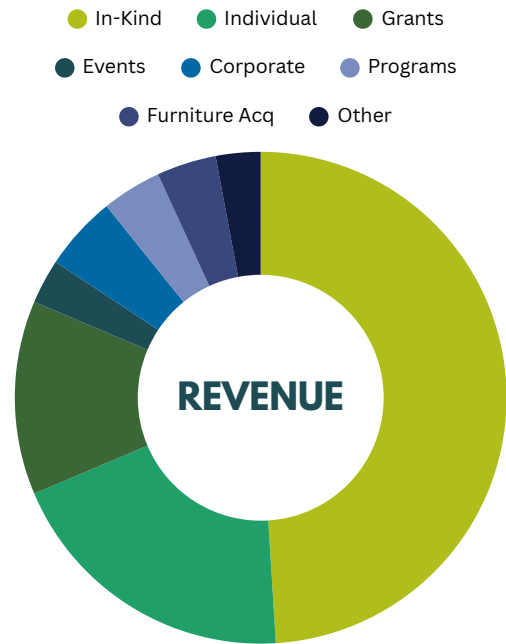

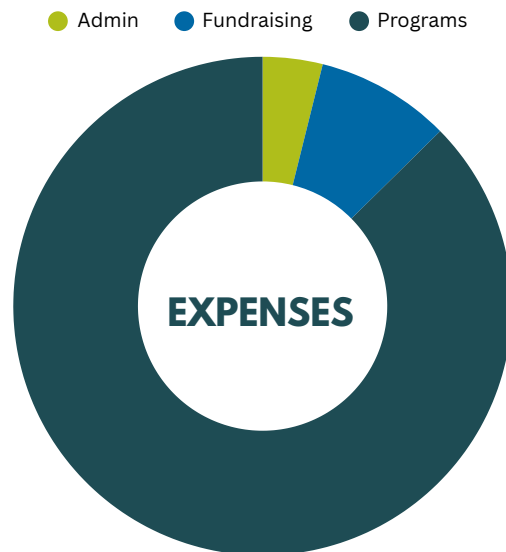
